THE PATHWAY OF JAUME I IN THE VALL D'ALBAIDA



The pathway of jaume I in the Vall d'Albaida

The Thematic Route from Jaume I to the Vall d'Albaida starts from the Corpus Christi Convent in Llutxent and ends at Vila d'Ontinyent, the starting point and end of the Cycling Tour. La Pobla del Duc, Montaverner and Bufali are the urban centers through which the route passes and all three are foundations created by Jaume I himself on old Islamic farmhouses. Montaverner in particular had a great importance since it is located at the confluence of the Albaida and Clariano rivers, and thus the Christian monarch assured the way to Alicante. Our route circulates through sidewalks and rural roads such as the Reial of Gandia street, in an itinerary designed for family tourism and to be done on foot, by bicycle or on horseback. Throughout the entire journey, the most humanized agricultural landscapes, surrounded by mountains and with a series of towns of great historical and patrimonial value, are discovered from the heart of the Vall. The medieval centers of Albaida, with the Castle Palace of the Milan of Aragón, the Corpus Christi Convent of Llutxent arising from the legend of the Corporales de Daroca and the Vila d'Ontinyent are more than enough arguments for a careful visit. The path of Jaume I is an invitation to discover, through his figure, the culture and landscape of a territory marked by history.

The Jaume I route to the Vall d'Albaida is a cultural tribute to the king who founded the Kingdom of Valencia and integrated the towns of the Vall d'Albaida into it.

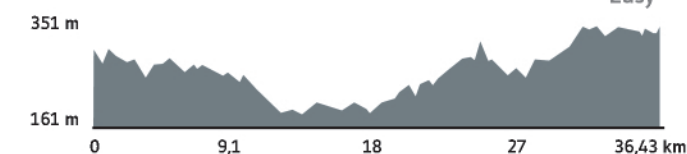
The pathway of Jaime I in the Vall d'Albaida Point of connection with the General Crossing: km 151. Llutxent

This thematic route based on the pathway of Jaime I that links the villages through which the monarch passed and are mentioned in the Book of Acts, allows you to complete the crossing of the Vall d'Albaida by a much quieter variant and without unevenness.

Cultural alternative for those who wish to know the artistic heritage of the towns of the Vall that are not linked in the general cycling route.

This linear route is suitable for cyclists and walkers, with a family character. This section joins the towns of Llutxent and Ontinyent.
